anything stating that the mayor had to be chair.

"The mayor may preside, he doesn't have to but he may preside, he may vote but he's not required to vote and any person that is elected to be a chairperson is done by a majority vote of all the members of the school committee," Mantolesky said.

Therefore, there must be a majority vote of every single member of the school committee in order to elect a chairman.

Mantolesky also wanted to clarify to the committee the function of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 43, which does state within it that a mayor should be chair of a school committee. However, she stated that this does not apply to Holyoke.

"Case law has come out, that is decades old, that essentially says that that statute, unless you choose one of the plans that are stated in the later section of that statute...the entire statute does not apply to you," Mantolesky said.

Given this information, Mantolesky encouraged the committee to elect a pro tem vice chair, and she also encouraged them to continue to look into the matter of electing a chair.

"I think you should keep a vice chair but I also think you should take this time to also elect a chairperson, just considering the language we have now, or you could table it," Mantolesky said.

The school committee was unable to vote on the matter of committee chair that evening, as

the item was not on the agenda. Additionally, they wanted to wait until there was further information revealed on the matter to make any final decisions.

For now they decided to elect a pro tem vice chair in order to give the committee and the city solicitors enough time to look for further information on committee policy and the city charter in order to decide how to best proceed with this matter.

"At least from now to Jan 2 we won't be out of line...and that will give us from now until our normal voting day in January to look into the minutes, to find some information somewhere that says otherwise," Garcia said. "So elect a vice chair and just continue what we're normally doing because then we won't be in conflict with anything."

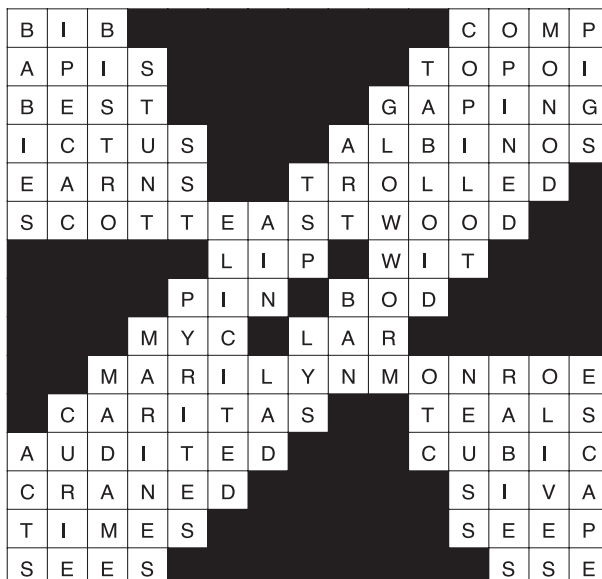
